

Parkside Pedestrian Bridge

Current Condition

The Parkside Pedestrian Bridge will connect the Mayfair and Parkside neighborhoods by flying over the Kenilworth Ave Freeway, CSX, and WMATA railroad tracks to provide safe, well-lit, ADA-accessible travel for local residents. The bridge is a step toward the District's mission of reconciling neighborhoods, eliminating transportation barriers, and facilitating access.



SAFETY

The bridge will improve safety by:

- Eliminating at-level pedestrian crossing on Kenilworth Ave Freeway
- Providing a well-lit pathway for pedestrians and bicyclists



AESTHETICS

Aesthetic features of the 400 ft. bridge will include:

- Two parallel arches at each end
- A metal roof to protect pedestrians and bicyclists
- Strong weathering steel with high corrosion resistance



ACCESSIBILITY

The bridge will increase bicycle and pedestrian accessibility by:

- Connecting pedestrians and bicyclists to the Minnesota Ave Metrorail and bus transfer stations
- Adding stairs and a 350 ft. long ADA compliant ramp
